



**MAITLAND STORMWATER LAKES MANAGEMENT PLAN
WETLAND TREE SHORELINE REVEGETATION PROGRAM
APPLICATION FORM**

To qualify for financial assistance

1. The project must not be a requirement of any regulatory agency.
2. An application form must be filed with the City of Maitland Public Works Department.
3. This program is entirely dependent upon the availability of city funds.
4. The application must be reviewed and approved by the city representative and a tree location established prior to the delivery of the tree (s).
5. Participating homeowners are responsible for the planting and maintenance of the trees.
6. Application must be received by the third Friday of the month for delivery to occur within that month.
7. All tree (s) requested are anticipated to be delivered the last Friday of the month between 1:00 P.M. and 3:00 P.M.

As part of its Stormwater Lakes Management Plan, the City of Maitland will provide up to three, 8-10 ft tall, Bald Cypress tree(s) to each participating lakefront homeowner at a cost of \$25.00 each. In cooperation with the homeowners, a city representative will establish the locations of the trees to ensure that the trees will benefit the lake.
